

Uniformed Group Activity Days

Aimed at uniformed groups, min number 20 children (smaller groups are welcome, but would still be charged as a group of 20), max number 120 children.

Our Activity days are designed with the intention of helping attendees to complete badge work through workshops and a visit to the museum. This can range from a small group of 20 children just having a visit without any workshops, to a large group having rotations of multiple activities. They can be done at weekends and during school holidays when available. Leaders wishing to bring larger groups may require a pre-visit to discuss their requirements with the learning team.

Activities

Within this package, you have the options of selecting up to three different hour long workshops or self-led activities for attendees to do throughout the day:

Costs

With regard to entrance cost, it is £7.50 per scout. Adults enter the museum free of charge at a ratio of 1:10, and additional adults pay the reduced price of £7.00 per person. Groups can attend just to visit the museum without any workshops if they so wish.

Workshops are priced at an additional £1.50 per session per child. It is your choice if you visit the museum by yourself, or have a Guided Tour. If you wish to have a guided tour, the costs are the same as a workshop.

Meals

As part of this package, Fleet Air Arm Museum will not provide any meals

However, should you still wish to book a lunch meal, cooked meals or lunch bags, these can be provided at an additional cost.

Payment

Depending on group size and extent of activity day, you may be required to provide a deposit. More information will be given regarding this at time of booking.

Museum Shop

Within your programme, there will be an opportunity for attendees to visit the shop. Should you wish for this to be removed from your programme, please let us know.

Risk Assessments

The museum risk assessment for sleepovers is available on request. We also have guidelines for group visits. For leaders preparing an event risk assessment these documents should be used to inform details of the assessment for the group visiting but cannot be regarded as definitive. Each group is different and the particular needs and circumstances of group members must be taken into account.
